

Summer Camp & Troop Outings Behavioral Expectations

TROOP 613 – ST. AUGUSTA, MN



Participation in Boy Scouts summer camp and troop activities is a privilege. In order to provide a positive, safe and learning environment while offering new and exciting challenges, the Troop Committee has established the following policies. These policies have been established so that all Scouts, parents and leaders are aware of them and so that everybody will be treated equally.

In order that these policies and the standards of the Boy Scouts of America and Troop 613 be upheld and uniformly enforced, I agree to the following:

- I agree to follow the posted or verbal schedule of activities and assignments as specified by the Troop leadership:

A Scout is TRUSTWORTHY

- I agree to be on time for all scheduled activities, merit badge sessions and camp activities:

A Scout is LOYAL

- I agree that if there is work to be done (even if it's not my responsibility) I will pitch in and help if needed, to help keep things on schedule:

A Scout is HELPFUL

- I agree to follow the "Buddy Rule" at all camp activities. If a Scout is alone, especially a new Scout, I will ask him to join in and get him involved:

A Scout is FRIENDLY

- When I am in camp or at a scheduled activity. I will act in a Scout-like manner and be considerate of others at all times:

A Scout is COURTEOUS

- I will not bring any electrical or battery powered games or radios to camp. I am at this camp or outing for the outdoor experience and to enjoy nature:

A Scout is KIND

- I agree that our Troop leaders are primarily responsible for the behavior, safety and welfare of myself and other scouts, and that all camp staff have the right and responsibility of helping and/or correcting any problem they encounter. While at camp I agree to comply with the "Outdoor Code":

A Scout is OBEDIENT

- I agree to be cooperative, even if something isn't going my way or I don't like the outcome of an activity. I won't quit. I'll stick with the task and I'll follow the program:

A Scout is CHEERFUL

- The Troop has provided equipment and/or made arrangements for tents and equipment for my use while at camp. I agree to take care of this equipment so it will be available for use by future Scouts. If I intentionally damage or destroy camp, Troop or someone else's equipment, I will be expected to pay for it:

A Scout is THRIFTY

- I agree to follow and abide by the rules of the "Totem Chip" while using knives, axes and saws. I also agree to inform an adult leader when any teasing or bullying of another scout is occurring:

A Scout is BRAVE

- I agree that I will not use or have in my possession any alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, tobacco (including smokeless) or any associated paraphernalia. If I am in violation of this, my parents and camp staff will be immediately notified and I will be sent home from this camp or outing:

A Scout is CLEAN

- I agree that the use of profanity or abusive language will not be tolerated and that the following will be the consequences. On the first offense I will receive a warning. On the second offense I will be given extra duties. On the third offense my parents will be called:

A Scout is REVERENT
